Admission Requirements

- honours undergraduate degree in Economics
- Minimum 75% (mid-B) average over the last two years of full-time undergraduate study
- Upper year undergraduate training in Economics (courses equivalent to ECON 3P90 Econometrics, ECON 3P91 Mathematical Economics, ECON 4P13 Advanced Macroeconomics, and ECON 4P14 Advanced Microeconomics)
- 3 letters of reference (academic)
- CV and statement of intent

Funding

- funding package for domestic students (approximately \$14000)
- funding package for international students (approximately \$21000)
- the packages include the Graduate Assistantship provides payment for you being a Graduate Teaching Assistant (approx 120 hours/term). We provide yearly training to all our TA with the aid of the CPI
- the Graduate Assistantship is put directly in your bank account
- the remaining portion is applied directly to your tuition

Fees vs funding: 1 year program

- Domestic: Funding (\$14000), Tuition ($\$2725 \times 3 = 8175$), Net: approx +\$5825 (less ancillary fees)
- International: Assitanship (\$21000), Tuition ($\$6725 \times 3 = 20505$), Net: approx +\$495 (less ancillary fees)

External scholarships

- 1 Students should consider applying for national and provincial scholarships:
 - [Canada Graduate Scholarships, Master's program](#) - \$27000 for 12 months, deadline is December 1 2025
 - [Ontario Graduate Scholarship](#) - \$15000 for 12 months, deadline is January 20 2025, open to Canadian citizen or permanent resident.
 - new this year: all applicants who list Brock University as a proposed host institution in their CGRS-M application will be automatically entered into Brock University's OGS competition
- 2 International and domestic students should also consider applying for entrance awards at time of application
