Important Notes

- SCIENCES CREDITS: Science credits must be from BCHM, BIOL, CHEM, COSC, ERSC, MATH, PHYS, and STAT (excluding ASTR 1P01, 1P02, BIOL 1F25, 1P23, 1P24, 1P27, 1P28, CHEM 1P00, ERSC 1P92, SCIE 1P50, 1P51 and 1P52).
- You must achieve a 70% major average and 60% non-major average by the end of third year to qualify for fourth year honours.
- Pass Degree = First three years of honours degree (15.0 credits)
- GEOG 4F90 (Honours Thesis) is open to GEOG and TOUR majors with a minimum 75% in all Year 3 GEOG/TOUR courses, approval to year 4 (honours), and permission of the Department. Students contemplating a thesis must consult with a possible Faculty Supervisor in D2 of Year 3. The student must submit a detailed proposal to the possible Faculty Supervisor by March 15 of D3 of Year 3.
- In 20 credit degree programs a maximum of eight credits may be numbered 1(alpha)00 to 1(alpha)99; at least three credits must be numbered 2(alpha)90 or above; at least three credits must be numbered 3(alpha)90 or above; and the remaining credits must be numbered 2(alpha)00 or above.
- In 15 credit degree programs a maximum of eight credits may be numbered 1(alpha)00 to 1(alpha)99; at least three credits must be numbered 2(alpha)90 or above; and the remaining credits must be numbered 2(alpha)00 or above.
- In some circumstances, in order to meet university degree and program requirements, more than 15 or 20 credits may be taken.
- This program plan is provided for information purposes only. It is the student's responsibility to ensure their courses meet degree requirements and adhere to prerequisites and exclusions outlined in the University Calendar.

Graduation Requirements

- **Honours Degree:** To graduate with a four-year honours degree, students must finish their program requirements with a minimum major average of 70% and non-major average of 60%.
- Pass Degree: To graduate with a three-year pass degree, students must finish their program requirements with a minimum major average of 60% and overall average of 60%.

From the "Graduation Standing" section of the Academic Regulations and University Policies in the Brock University Undergraduate Calendar:

- i. First-class Honours degrees are granted to students who have completed a 20-credit honours program with first-class honours standing, which requires a minimum 80% average in all major credits and 70% in the remaining credits. A transfer student must also have completed a minimum of five credits at Brock, including all departmental honours requirements for year 4 and have maintained a minimum 75% overall average and a minimum 80% major average (based on Brock courses only).
- ii. Second-class Honours degrees are granted to students who have completed a 20-credit honours program with second-class honours standing, which requires a minimum 70% average in all major credits and 60% in the remaining credits. A transfer student must also have completed a minimum of five credits at Brock, including all departmental honours requirements for year 4 and have maintained a minimum 65% overall average and a minimum 70% major average (based on Brock courses only).
- iii. A degree with Distinction is granted to students who have completed the approved 15-credit pass degree or 20-credit non-honours degree with a minimum 80% overall average. Transfer students require a minimum 80% cumulative average in all Brock courses and a minimum 80% overall average.
- iv. A Pass (15 credit), Non-Honours (20 credit) or With Major (20 credit) degree is granted to students who have completed an approved program with a minimum 60% overall and 60% in the courses designated as major credits.
- v. Students may not modify a degree standing after it has been awarded by taking additional courses to upgrade their standing, nor, once a degree is conferred, may the final record of courses comprising that degree be changed in any manner.
