Position Summary

Tutoring is a great way to make a positive contribution to the Brock community while keeping your memory sharp and developing in-demand interpersonal and problem-solving skills.

A-Z Learning Services Tutors will provide academic sessions on a one-on-one basis to Brock University students, as well as community clients. All tutors are free to tutor any course or age range they are comfortable with. In general, we prefer to hire tutors with well-rounded experience and who are open to tutoring in-person, online, and with community clients, though this is not a requirement. An up-to-date vulnerable sector clearance is required to work with underage community clients, which can be acquired after joining the tutoring team.

The tutor will meet with students at a pre-arranged date and time and will assist the student in regards to the course material/curriculum, while complying with academic integrity standards. In-person tutoring sessions are held on the Brock campus in the Student Success Centre, TH 129; Online sessions are currently delivered using Microsoft Teams.
