THE CITIES OF ST CATHARINES AND THOROLD ARE WORKING TO HELP CREATE SAFE AND ACCESSIBLE NEIGHBOURHOODS.

PLEASE BE AWARE OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, AND THE WELL-BEING OF YOUR COMMUNITY. BELOW ARE SOME COMMON BYLAWS, AND THE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THEM.



Having nuisance parties, including selling alcohol, public intoxication	\$450 - \$1000
Creating excessive noise (e.g., music, shouting) especially between 11pm and 7am.	\$300 - \$750
Obstructing an officer, including failing to identify.	\$1000 - \$5,000 fine (Local By-law)
Trespassing and other property offences	\$50 - \$10,000 fine and possible arrest (Trespass to Property Act)
Liquor Offenses, including the sale of alcohol at your party	\$50-\$100,000 fine and possible arrest (Liquor License Act)
Leaving, throwing, or depositing bottles, glasses or other materials on public or private property	\$250 -\$750 fine
Urinating, defecating, spitting, or vomiting in public .	Up to \$300 (Local By-law)
Driving under the influence	Possible arrest & incarceration (Highway Traffic Act)

In St Catharines, property owners (landlords) can now also receive penalties for the behaviour of their tenants. Thorold Bylaw Officers now ride with Niagara Regional Police Officers to improve their enforcement efforts.

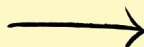
We encourage open and honest communication between property owners, home owners and home renters on concerns related to gatherings
