The City of Thorold is working to help create safe and accessible neighbourhoods. Below are some common bylaws and the fines associated with them.

|  Cause or permit noise by the squealing of tires of a motor vehicle | \$300 |
|  Cause or permit noise from a bell, horn, siren or other warning device on a motor vehicle | \$300 |
|  Cause or permit noise from device or instrument that is audible within residential unit with windows closed | \$300 |
|  Littering without written authority | \$300 |
|  Fail to keep land clear of waste | \$300 |
|  Leave, throw or deposit bottles, glasses or material on public or private property | \$300 |
|  Urinate, defecate, vomit or spit in a public place | \$500 |
|  Knock over or attempt to knock over a Canada Post mailbox, Canada Post relay box, newspaper box, fence, bench, blue box, garbage container or other structure or object in a public place | \$300 |
|  Loiter in a public place | \$150 |
|  Participate in a fight in a public place | \$300 |
|  Participate in a nuisance party | \$300 |
|  Cause or permit noise during a prohibited time | \$300 |







In some cases, property owners can receive penalties for the behaviour of their tenants. Niagara Regional Police Officers work closely with bylaw officers in their enforcement efforts.
