Perennial Mix

This mix of perennial flowers will provide many colours for years of enjoyment. When fall planted, the flowers will blossom the following spring. When spring planted, if the conditions are right, there will be some flowering, but most will not flower until the following spring.

Type: Perennial

Height: 110cm

Exposure: Full sun to partial shade

Difficulty: Easy



Growing

Direct sow seeds during the period two weeks before, and eight weeks after, your last average frost date. Seeds can also be sown in the autumn, but some may be lost to water, birds, and animals.

Scatter seeds by hand over the desired planting area. Seeds must come into contact with the soil in order to germinate. Do not bury seeds more than 2-3 times their thickness.

Keep the seeded area as evenly moist as possible to help the seeds germinate and the young seedlings become established.

Saving

Allow the pods to remain on the plant until they have dried and begun to turn brown, being careful not to wait too long to the point where they split open themselves. Carefully remove the pods and open them to expose the seeds inside. Separate the seeds from the pods and spread them out in a single layer in a cool, dry place. Put the seeds into a dated and labeled envelope and return to Brock!
