REPORT OF THE ACTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

The <u>687th meeting of Senate</u> was held on February 10, 2021. The <u>Faculty Handbook</u> has been updated to reflect any approved policy changes. During the meeting, Senate undertook the following actions:

- received a Report from the Undergraduate Program Committee, and
 - approved the following amendment to Faculty Handbook 3: A.7.6 to provide a limitation on the number of disruption credits (CD) a student may apply towards a micro-certification program (highlight indicates insertion)
 - 7.6 ACADEMIC REGULATIONS PERTAINING TO CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

- 11. The use of disruption credits (CD) is prohibited for micro-certificate programs.

 - approved that the election of representatives to fill Senate vacancies occurring at the end of Spring Convocation, with the exception of student representatives, close on March 29, 2021
