

REPORT OF THE ACTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE

A meeting of the <u>2021-22 Senate-Elect</u> and the <u>691st meeting of Senate</u> were held on May 26, 2021. The <u>Faculty Handbook</u> has been updated to reflect any approved policy changes. During the meeting, Senate undertook the following actions:

- appointed Jens Coorssen as the faculty member representative to serve on Brock University's Board of Trustees for a three-year term ending June 30, 2024
