# **Leadership Camp Itinerary**

(9:15 A.M.)

#### **Bus Arrival and Check in**

Students will be greeted by staff and provided option for a bathroom break. They will then be escorted to program Space. Teacher to provide group details and hand in program health forms.

#### **Icebreakers**

In a large group staff will lead students through fun and engaging ice breaking activities.

#### **Group Time**

Class will be split into instructor groups of roughly 10 students per group. Name game activities and goal setting for the days programming.

## **Team Building & Low Ropes**

Solve puzzles, obstacles, and physical challenges while you practice collaboration, communication, problem solving, and leadership as a team.

## (12:00 P.M.)

Adventure Course & Rock Climbing Experience our 30 foot high ropes challenge course and our outdoor rock-climbing tower. These challenge-by-choice events are a great way to strengthen communication skills while pushing personal boundaries in a safe and controlled environment. Specialty staff coach and encourage students along the way.

# Alternative to climbing options:

#### **Hiking Niagara's Escarpment**

Discover the beauty of the Bruce Trail, the UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, and learn more about the ecology of the region, all in Brock's backyard.

## **Egg Drop**

Students will test their engineering and design skills by building a container to keep an egg safe from a high fall. Using supplies provided student must use their creativity and only a handful of materials to protect the egg during its epic stunt
